TO BE COMPLETED BY ALL APPLICANTS:

The following **MUST** be provided:

1. A completed **Rita Strong Bursary application form**. Include the contact details of two referees.
2. Students who are currently registered must provide **Proof of Registration**.
3. **Certified transcript of your academic results** (scan copy).
4. **Curriculum Vitae** (in pdf format).
5. **Bio/Artist's Statement** (maximum 200 words in pdf format).
6. **Motivation**: your study aims at the CVA (maximum 200 words in pdf format)
7. **Portfolio of academic and/or creative works already produced**. As a guideline this should include:

(a) For studio practice degrees:

A representative selection of your portfolio and a written outline of your intended study in approximately 300 words. Each image must include the title of the work, date of production, media, size (height, width, breadth as applicable), animation/film (recent digital work of 2 to 5 minutes duration with fully attributed production credits).

(b) For theory only degrees:

Approximately 500 words defining your area of research, or an extract of no more than 1000 words from a recent article / paper/ critique / written essay with fully captioned illustrations and reference list (in pdf format).

PROCESS OF APPLICATION:

Once your Rita Strong Bursary application been received:

- (a) Successful applicants will be informed by email of the Committee's decision
- (b) The decision of the Rita Strong Committee is final
- (c) No application will be returned to the student by the Committee
- (d) Only applications submitted in the correct format will be considered

4. CONDITIONS OF THE BURSARY:

1. Successful applicants must undertake to contribute actively to the CVA community throughout the duration of the degree or diploma.
2. Recipients must undertake to repay the Rita Strong Bursary IN FULL if he/she withdraws, de-registers or fails to re-register for a continuing semester from the specific degree/qualification for which this Rita Strong Bursary is granted. Further, in such circumstances, the applicant will be liable for all costs incurred in the recovery of this Rita Strong Award.
3. The Rita Strong Bursary and the Centre for Visual Arts must be acknowledged in any portfolio, exhibition, text, application or presentation that the successful applicant may embark on throughout this degree.
4. All other bursaries or awards (NRF or privately) granted must be declared. Failure to do so may result in any award offered by the Rita Strong Committee being forfeited and the full amount (if already paid) will become repayable.
